Infants and toddlers with:

- Delayed speech and/or walking
- Inefficient neck control after 4 months
- Inconsistent sleep patterns after 5 months
- Difficulty in sitting alone after 7 months

School-aged children having difficulties in:

- Spelling
- Reading
- Staying on task
- Essay planning and writing
- Handwriting and letter spacing
- Social skills (interpreting verbal and body language cues)
